Total 25 NSS volunteers and one Programme officer, one Assistant program officer and 4 support person participated in the camp.

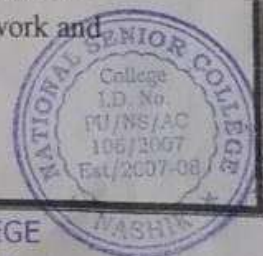
In these seven days Special Camp different activities were organised as –

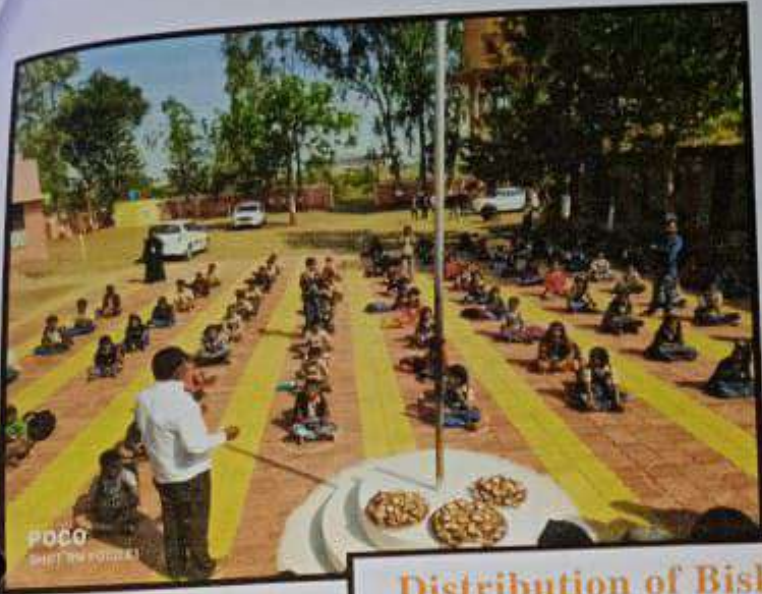

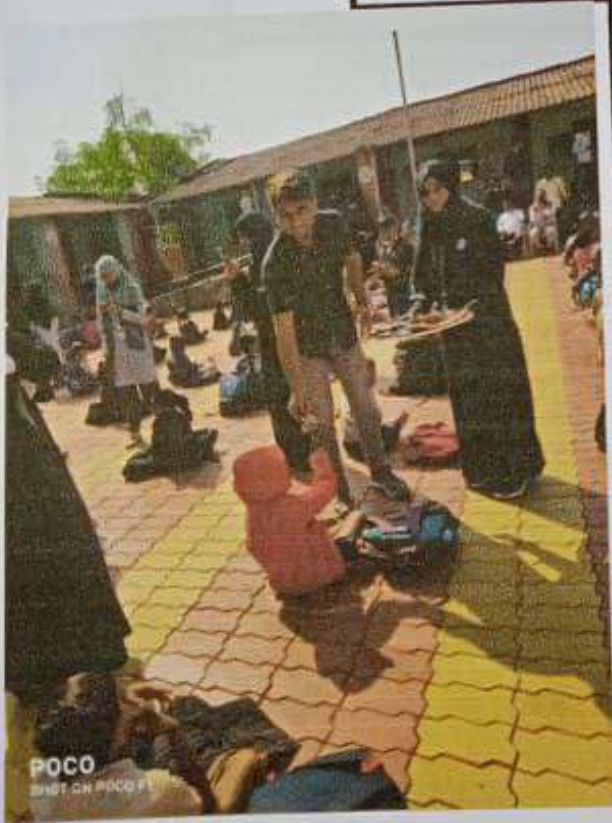

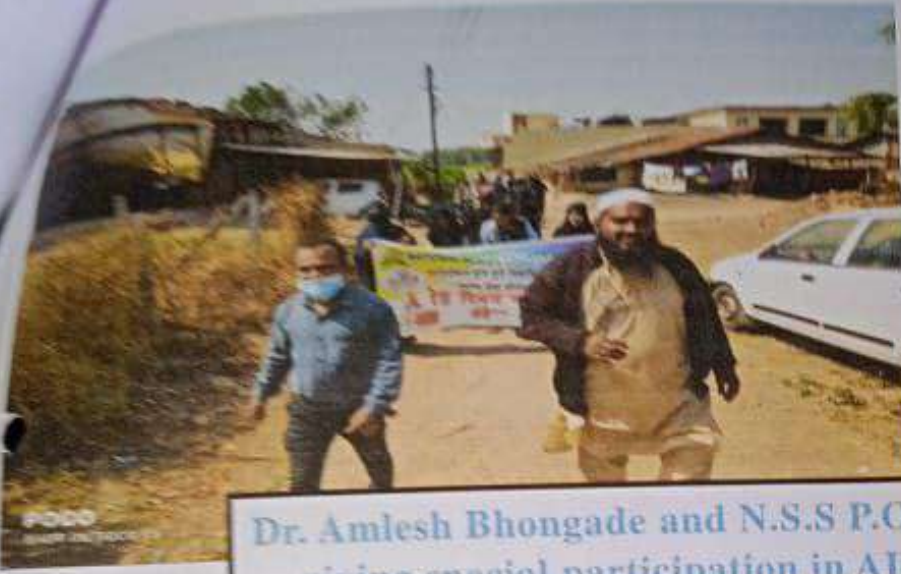
