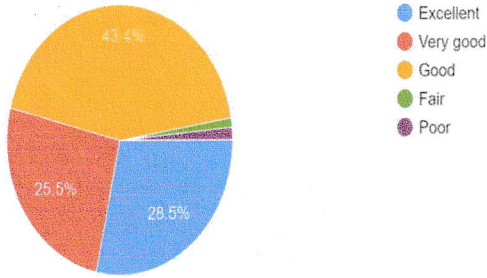

Graphical Representation of Students' Feedback:2023-24



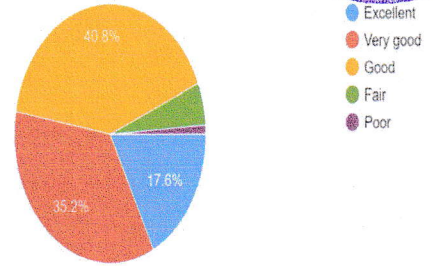

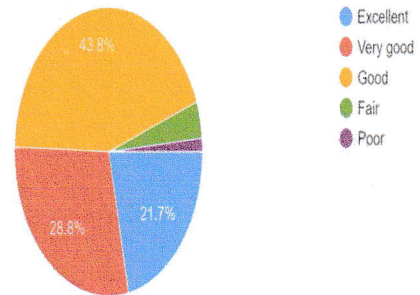

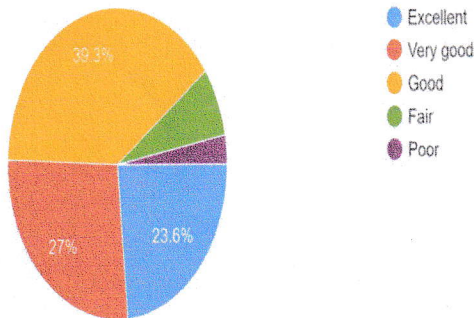
4. How do you rate the extension of the course curriculum in overseas career options

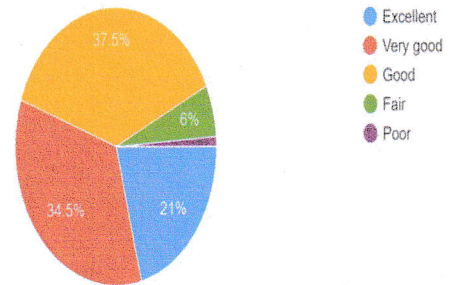

Graphical Representation of Analysis Report: 2023-24



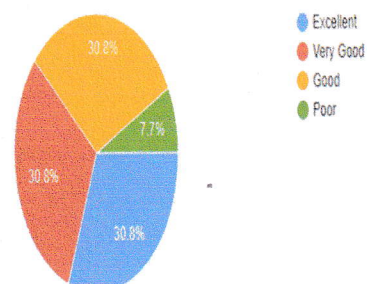

Graphical Representation of Analysis Report: 2023-24



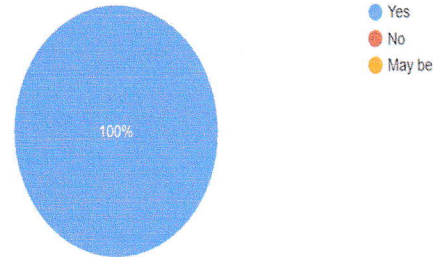

Graphical Representation of Analysis Report: 2023-24



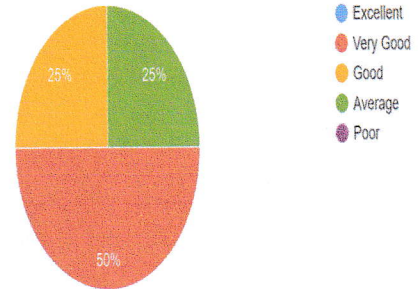
