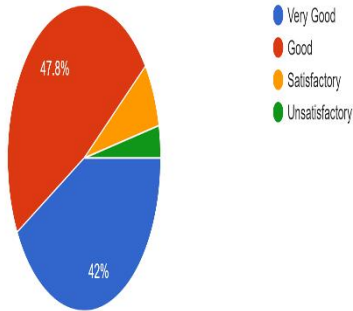

Graphical Representation of Students' Feedback:2022-23



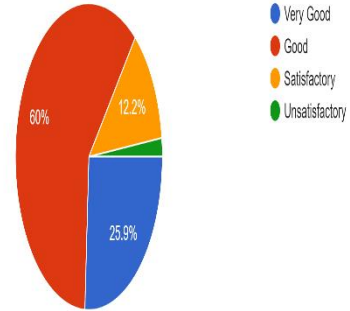
1. Depth of syllabus content is?

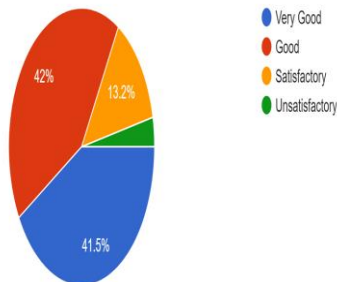
2. Whether syllabus is carrier oriented?

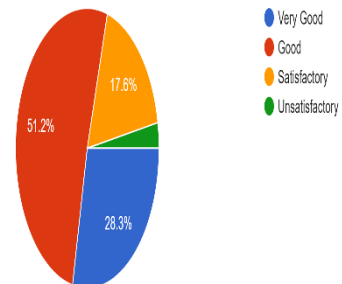
3. Interest generated by Teacher regarding syllabus is?

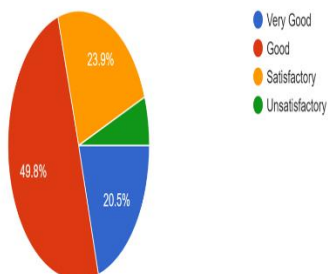
4. How do you rate the sequence of units in the syllabus?

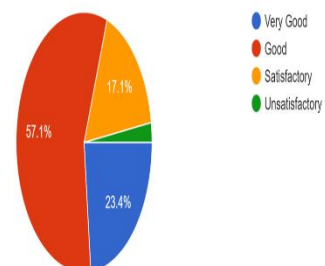
5. Rate the size of syllabus in terms of load on the student?

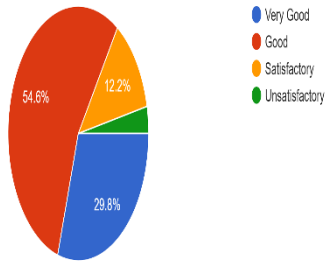


6. How do you rate the objectives stated and relevance to the course content?

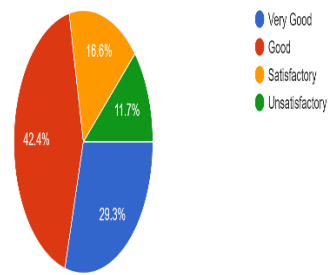

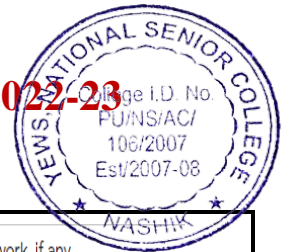

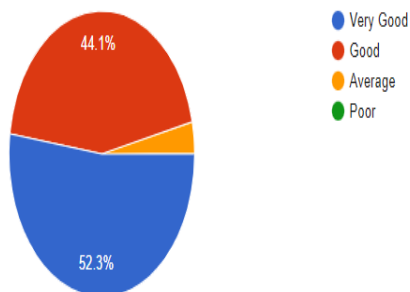


Graphical Representation of Analysis Report: 2022-23



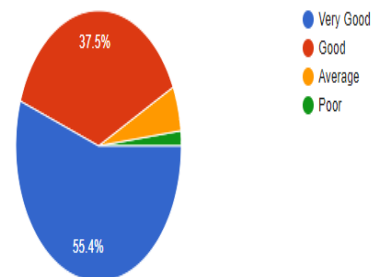
1. Diversity & extent of courses covered

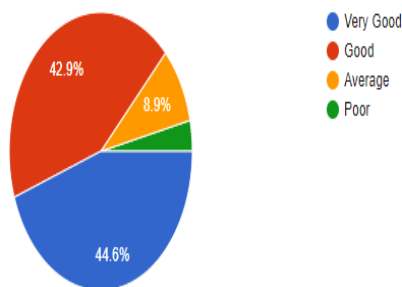
2. Depth of the course content including project work, if any

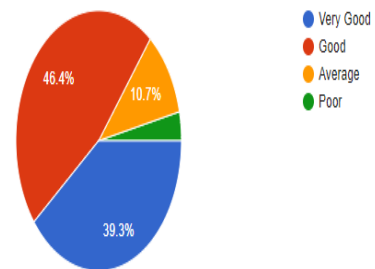
3. Employment orientation in the curriculum

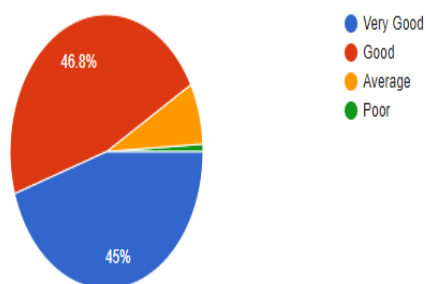
4. Topics for competitive examinations included in the syllabus

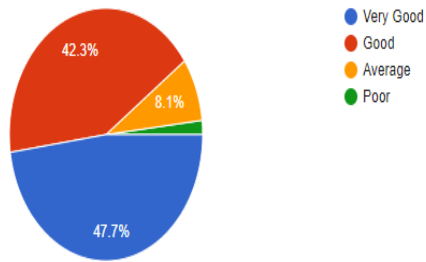

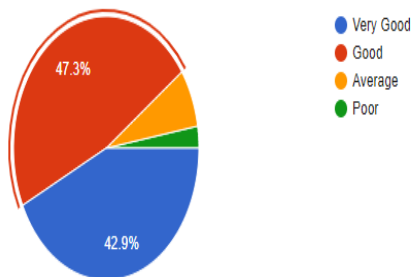
8. Scope for the use of ICT

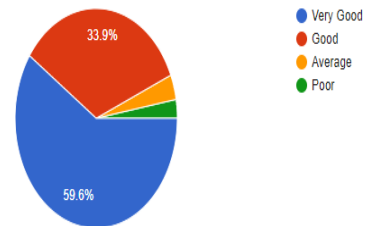
9. Research orientation obtained during the programme

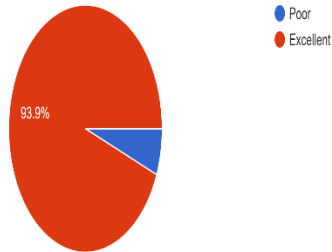

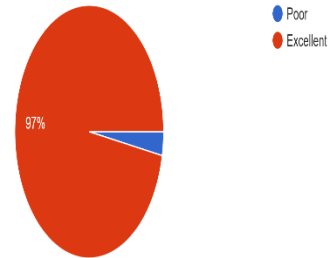
1. How would you rate the teaching learning process of the institute?

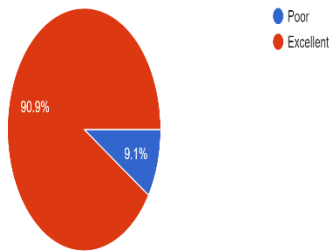
2. How would you rate the curriculum?

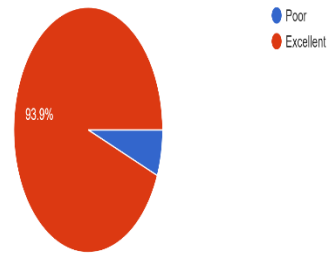
3. How would you rate the institute on usage of innovative teaching method?

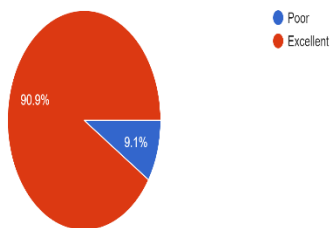
4. How would you rate the institute on result of the institute?

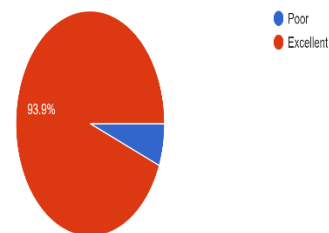
5. How would you rate the institute on support provided for organization of & participation in co-curricular activities for students?

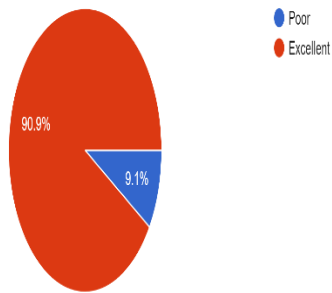
6. How would you rate the institute on support provided for organization of & participation in extra-curricular activities for students?

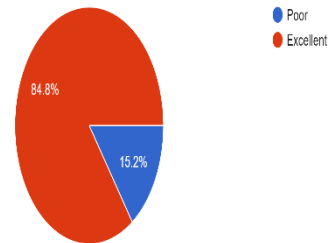

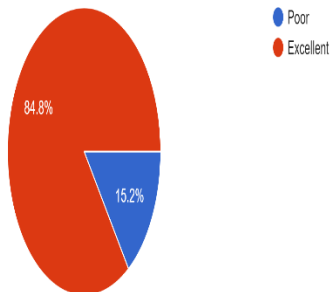
8. How would you rate the institute on interaction with industry by faculty?

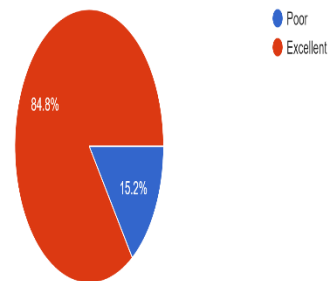

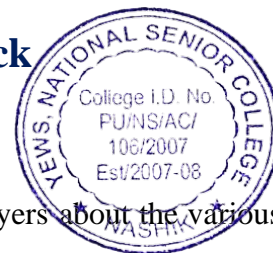

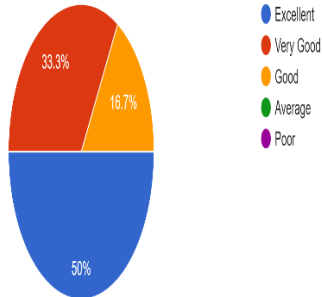


Graphical Representation of Analysis Report: 2022-23



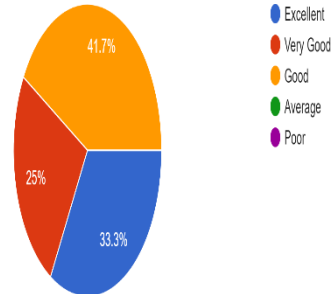
1) How you find our student with respect to Technical skills?

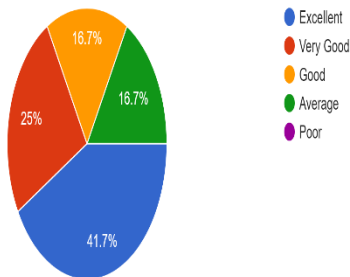
2) How you find our student with respect to Communication Skills?

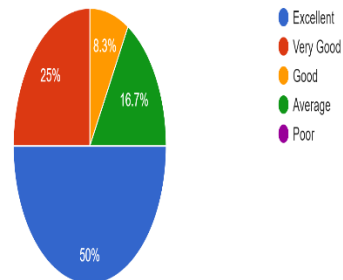
3) How you rate our student with respect to Independent thinking & problem solving ability?

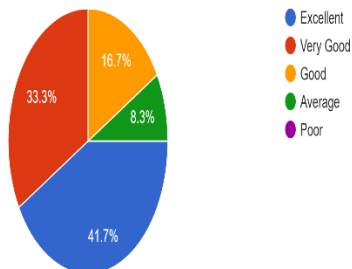
4) How you rate our student with respect to Leadership skills/ Ability to work in team?

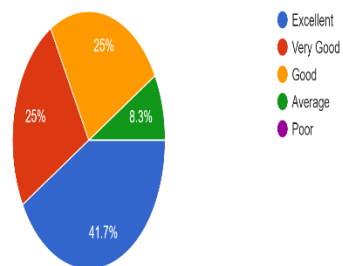
5) Rate the proficiency of our graduates to adapt to industry requirement.

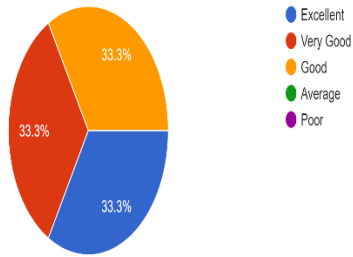
6) How do you rate our students with respect to overall performance in terms of percentage contribution to your organization?

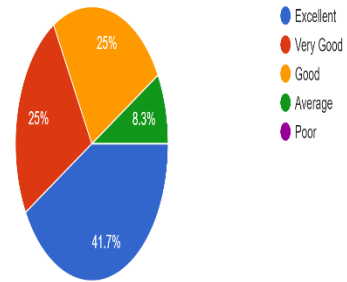

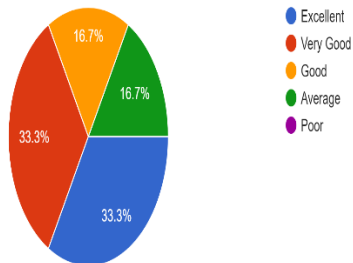
