Admission Procedure:

- 1. Students passing XII (HSC) or its equivalent are eligible for admission to the respective faculty.
- 2. Student seeking admission to this college will have to submit admission form duly filled in along with the required fees, on the specified date.
- 3. Following documents must be attached with the admission form
 - a. Statement of marks of the previous latest examination(two attested true copies)
 - b. School leaving certificate/transfer certificate(original+ two attested copies)
 - c. Necessary documents such as scholarship form etc.
 - d. Adhaar Card (student and parent/Guardian)
- 4. Student seeking admission to the first year will have confirm after University eligible process along with necessary.
- 5. Students seeking admission to the first year will have to undergo medical checkup by the authorized medical officer. The application for eligible number will be sent to the University only after the medical certificate is produced.
 - Students from other University will have to submit the following document:
 - Migration certificate.
 - Statement of marks of the previous examination.
 - Character certificate of the School/college attended last.
 - Attendance certificate
 - Passing certificate
- 6. a) 2 Copies of passport size recent photographs of student & parants, one to be affixed on the space left for photograph on the admission form and other will be used for the Identity Card.

b) Students seeking admission to this College should submit original copies of the School Leaving Certificate, Transfer Certificate and Marks Sheet of the previous examination with two attested photocopies of each document.

c) Students taking admission to this College but who have passed their previous examination from other Board/University should submit two attested photocopies of migration certificate and mark sheet of previous examination.

- 7. Necessary fees shall be paid along with the duly filled in admission form accompanied with the required documents(original & attested true copies)
- 8. Students will be admitted provisionally and the admission will be confirmed only on the receipt of eligibility number from the University.
- 9. After admission, Identity Cards duly signed by the college authority would be issued to the students Identity Card should be produced by the whenever demanded by the college authority.

The regulations jointly made by the University of Pune, Education Council, State Government and College Management will have to be strictly followed by all students.

- 2) Use of Mobile in college campus is strictly prohibited.
- If any incident of ragging come to the notice of the Authority concerned, the accused student will be given an opportunity to explain & if his explanation is not found satisfactory, the authority would expel him from institution (as per University of Pune circular no 170 of 2009)

- 21) Use of unfair means and copy material in the examination is a punishable offence.
- 22) Original certificate once submitted will not be returned.
- 23) Strict action will be taken if any alternation in document are made.
- 24) No circles, organization other than academic forums of student should be formed in the campus.
- 25) The examination forms of the student will be detained if their attendance is less than 75%.
- 26) Student should be have politely with teaching & Non-teaching staff.
- 27) Always help to keep the campus clean.
- 28) Co-operate to maintain discipline in the campus. If you see any one including in act of Indiscipline, report the same to the principal immediately.

Facilities:

1) Seminar Hall:
