The regulations jointly made by the University of Pune, Education Council, State Government and College Management will have to be strictly followed by all students.

- 1. NOTICE BOARD EVERY DAY FOR NOTICES, CIRCULARS & NOTIFICATIONS. Develop the habit of reading the.
- 2. Use of Mobile in college campus is strictly prohibited.
- 3. If any incident of ragging comes to the notice of the Authority concerned, the accused student will be given an opportunity to explain & if his explanation is not found satisfactory, the authority would expel him from institution (as per University of Pune circular no 170 of 2009)
