### **Admission Procedure :**

1. Students passing XII (HSC) or its equivalent examination are eligible for admission to the respective faculty.
2. Students seeking admission to this college will have to submit admission form duly filled in along with the required fees, on the specified date.
3. Following documents must be attached with the admission form:
  - a) Statement of marks of the previous latest examination ( two attested true copies )
  - b) School leaving certificate/transfer certificate ( original + two attested copies )
  - c) Necessary documents such as scholarship/fees concession form etc.
4. Students seeking admission to the first year will have to apply for the University eligibility certificate along with necessary fees.
5. Students seeking admission to the first year will have to undergo medical checkup by the authorized medical officer. The application for eligibility certificate will be sent to the University only after the medical certificate is produced.
6. Students from other University will have to submit the following documents:
  - Migration certificate.
  - Statement of marks of the previous examination.
  - Character certificate of the school/college attended last.
  - Attendance certificate.
  - Passing certificate.
  - Parents or Guardians Adhar Card
7.
  - a) 2 Copies of passport size recent photographs,, one to be affixed on the space left for photograph on the admission form and other will be used for the Identity Card.
  - b) Students from other colleges seeking admission to this College should submit original copies of the School Leaving Certificate, Transfer Certificate and Mark Sheet of the previous examination with two attested photocopies of each document.

- c) Students taking admission to this College but who have passed their previous examination from other Board/University should submit two attested photocopies of migration certificate and mark sheet of previous examination.
8. Necessary fees shall be paid along with the duly filled in admission form accompanied with the required documents (original & attested true copies)
  9. Students will be admitted provisionally and the admission will be confirmed only on the receipt of eligibility certificate from the University.
  10. After admission, Identity Cards duly signed by the college authority would be issued to the students. Identity Card should be produced by the student whenever demanded by the college authority.

**Cancellation of Admission and refund of fees:**

The candidate cancelling his confirmed admission will be entitled to the refund of fees after deducting the amount as indicated below except otherwise prescribed by the state Government, University or other competent authority.

➔ **STUDENTS COUNCIL :**

In accordance with the rules and regulations of university of Pune, Students Council will be formed to promote the literary, social, cultural and extra curricular activities.

➔ **RULES AND DISCIPLINE:-**

Students will follow all the norms of discipline of this college. Rules regarding routine work, behaviour in the campus, classrooms and library, at various functions and during examinations should be properly observed by all students.

The regulations jointly made by the University of Pune, Education Council, State Government and College Management will have to be strictly followed by all students.

1. NOTICE BOARD EVERY DAY FOR NOTICES, CIRCULARS & NOTIFICATIONS. Develop the habit of reading the.
2. Use of **Mobile** in college campus is strictly prohibited.
3. If any incident of ragging comes to the notice of the Authority concerned, the accused student will be given an opportunity to explain & if his explanation is not found satisfactory, the authority would expel him from institution (as per University of Pune circular no 170 of 2009)
4. Students must carry their Identity Cards with them.
5. Students must behave decently. They should be polite to the staff and other students.
6. Vehicles must be parked at parking place only.
7. Students must not bunk lectures/practicals.
8. Smoking, drinking liquor, consuming gutka, pan masala and pan, and spitting are strictly prohibited in the college campus.
9. Photography in the campus is not allowed.
10. Weapons that may cause physical injury are prohibited in the campus.
11. Writing anything on the walls of classroom or in toilets, throwing scraps anywhere in the campus are prohibited.
